Keynote Speaker

DR. CYNTHIA SECOR is the founding director of Higher Education Resource Services (HERS) and the Summer Institute at Bryn Mawr College. She had served as director since the organization’s inception in 1976 until earlier this academic year, when HERS hired its second director, Dr. Judith S. White.

Dr. Secor now serves as senior research associate. Dr. Secor became the director of the Management Institute in 1984 and is a founder of the NACAWAA/HERS Institute for Administrative Advancement, which offers women coaches and athletic administrators intensive training in athletic administration.

HERS, located in the Merle C. Chambers Center for the Advancement of Women at the University of Denver, sponsors professional development activities designed to improve the status of women in higher education and is engaged in three programs – the Summer Institute for Women in Higher Education Administration, the HERS New England Management Institute for Women in Higher Education and the HERS South Africa Program to facilitate professional development of women.

Dr. Secor holds a bachelor’s degree in political science from Bryn Mawr College, a master’s degree and a doctorate from Cornell University in English literature. She has published articles on prose fiction, literary criticism and women in higher education administration.

Dr. Secor continues to write on the career avenues and issues of women employed in higher education. She is widely recognized as a developer of leadership programs and as a scholar in women’s studies. Dr. Secor has done extensive consulting and has conducted training programs at many colleges and universities.

For all of her efforts on behalf of women in higher education, Dr. Secor was honored by the National Association of Women in Education (NAWE) with the organization’s first award for lifetime achievement.
